NEWS PUBLISHING COMPANY – REQUEST TO USE STAGING AREA

Kevin Myrick, Editor of the Cedartown Standard appeared before the Commission requesting the use of the staging area on Main Street on Wednesday, May 7, 2014 from 6 p.m. to 7 p.m. for a get together for combining the Rockmart Journal and the Cedartown Standard into one paper. On motion by Commissioner Foster, seconded by Commissioner Martin, all voting “Aye” none voting “No” the Commission approved the request for News Publishing Company to use the staging area on Wednesday, May 7, 2014 from 6 p.m. to 7 p.m. for a get together for combining the Rockmart and Cedartown papers into one paper.

TURNER STREET PARK FACILITIES

Commissioner Hubbard spoke to the Commission regarding the use of the Turner Street Park facility being returned back to the City. Commissioner Hubbard discussed the need for an outside bathroom at Turner Street. City Manager Fann stated that porta toilets will be placed at the facility, locks changed and the city will be in charge of the Turner Street facility.
