

Cedartown Transit Title VI Policy

Cedartown Transit Non-Discrimination policy towards those protected under Title VI prohibits discrimination in programs and activities receiving Federal financial assistance. Specifically, Title VI provides that “no person in the United States shall be excluded from participation in, be denied the benefits of, or be subjected to discrimination under any program or activity receiving Federal financial assistance”.

Cedartown Transit is committed to ensuring that no person is excluded from participation in, or denied, the benefits of its transit services on the basis of the Title VI Non-Discrimination Policy, as protected by Title VI in the Federal Transit Administration (FTA) Circular 4702.1.A.
