The living memorials, planted by the Cedartown Parks Department, can be located at Bert Wood Youth and Athletic Complex, Goodyear Park, Peek Park or Turner Street Park. Purchasers will be able to choose the type of tree and the park location, but planting time will take place between the months of October through February, weather permitting. The living memorial program is open to individuals, families, businesses and civic groups.

The investment for a living memorial is \$500.00, which includes a 2-inch caliper tree (trunk measures 2 inches in diameter), planting, and the placement of a bronze plaque commemorating an individual or special date.
